

# Art 2 sketchbook mp1 part 1

5 pages are due twice each marking period.

Create a clear indicator where the marking period starts. Make a small indicator in the corner **MP1a**

Fill each page with a successful design covering all white spaces. Points will be deducted for minimal black and white as well as underdeveloped pages.

Create one page with 10 different, significant sized, drawings of the insect of your choice. Be sure you are drawing the same type of insect 10 times. Wash the entire background of the page with a single color of watercolors.

Include a 2-page **HAND WRITTEN** artist study in complete sentences on one of the listed artists and their work. Choose 1 artist below.

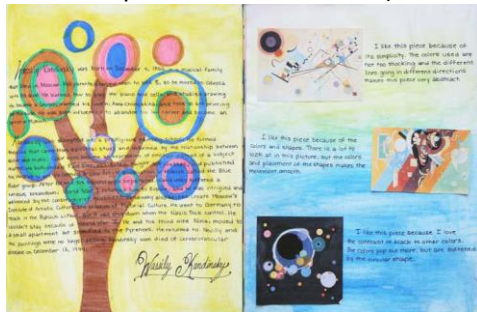
