

Eames Project Part 1 – Chair Legacy – Due March 28th

As a team, create a chair for the computer art studio.

What are the materials for your chair?

Is it newly fabricated or made from an existing chair or chair parts?

Consider the durability of your chair.

Will it stand the test of time with high school students?

How do you make an interesting and artistic expression?

Your chair should be comfortable for students to sit in for long hours.

What would the most popular chair in the class look like?

What would the most unique chair look like?

Is this a pre-existing chair that will be seen in a new way? **Think surface.**

Your chair must relate to the content of Computer Art! (Or otherwise approved by Mr. McCray)

Materials that can be provided – glue sticks, hot glue gun, paint

Consult Mr. McCray for small construction assembly using screws and hand drill

You may consider visiting the dump, looking in the attic, or asking friends for old or discarded chairs or stools.
