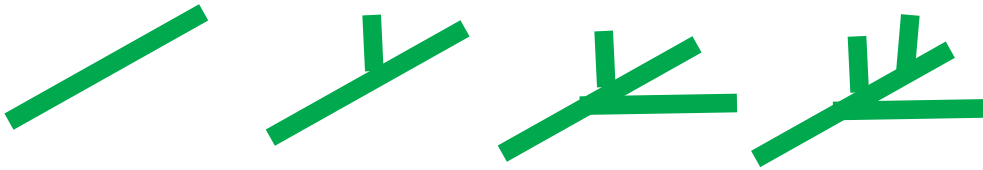


regular rhythm - visual rhythm achieved through repeating identical motifs using the same space between them.



progressive rhythm - visual rhythm that changes a motif every time it is repeated.



flowing rhythm - visual rhythm created by repeating wavy lines.



Movement - principle of design that deals with creating the illusion of action or physical change in position

Rhythm - principle of art that indicates movement by the repetition of elements or objects.

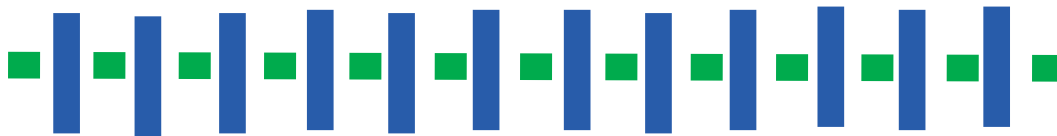
Visual Rhythm - Rhythm you perceive through your eyes rather than through your ears.

motif - unit repeated in visual rhythm

Random Rhythm - Visual rhythm in which the motif is repeated in no apparent order.

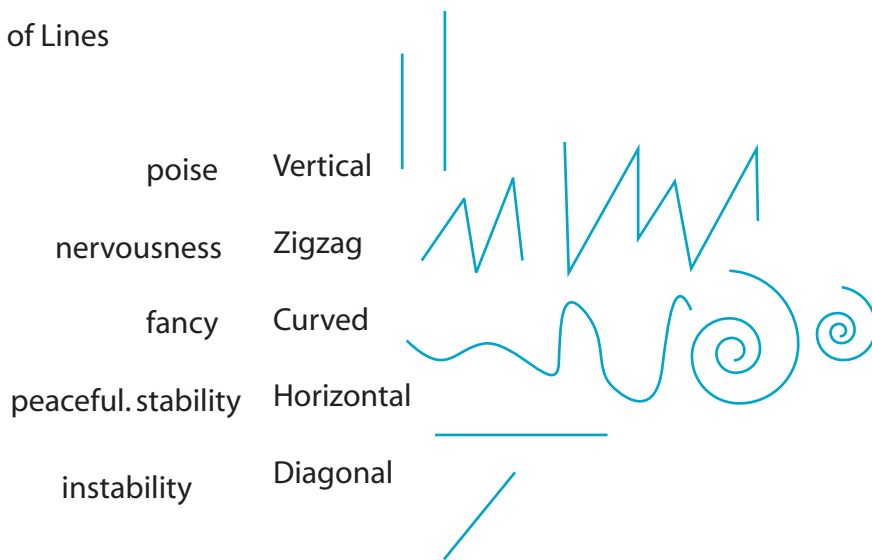


Alternating Rhythm - Visual rhythm set up by repeating motifs but changing position or content of motifs or spaces between them.



Line - An Element of Art that is the path of a moving point through space

5 Kinds of Lines



Lines can vary in 5 major ways

Length Width Texture Direction Degree of curve



Static Lines - Inactive - horizontal and vertical lines

Active Lines - Expressing movement - diagonal, curved, and zig-zag
