

Vik Muniz/Impressionism Project

In the style of Vik Muniz, create a new version of a classic Impressionism piece.

Part 1 – Select an Impression or Post Impressionism Piece

Select an image of an Impressionism or Post Impressionism work of art. The images can be found by clicking the link, “impressionism gallery” on Mr. McCray’s website. Find an image that is unique and speaks to you. Once you have decided which image you are going to use, fill in your name next to the coordinating image on the impressionism project sign up doc. The link is on mccrayart.com. Download your image and print **IN COLOR**.

Part 2 – Consider the materials for your artwork

Magazine imagery for collages will be provided for artwork. You may consider using other “outside the box” materials that will need to be approved by Mr. McCray. You would be responsible for any other materials that would be chosen for your project. Be sure to select materials that will work with the scale of the imagery. Can you find elements to use for you image that could relate more directly to the content of the image?

Part 3 – Duplicate the image with a grid system

To produce an accurate rendering and speed up the drawing process you will first create a grid system of your image onto your drawing. Mr. McCray will assist the class with this process.

Part 4- Make it!

This project is initially a **VALUE STUDY**. You will need to think about finding imagery with a similar value to what you see in the photograph. While searching for collage materials, you should be focusing mostly on value and color, rather than subject matter.
