

Make your own emoji!

Part 1 – In your sketchbook, create a single page of 12 thumbnail sketches in preparation for the following assignment. Have Mr. McCray check your thumbnail page before you begin working in Illustrator. You may use this page as part of the MP2a sketchbook assignment only if all whitespace is covered with multiple colors.

Part 2 - In Illustrator, create 5 original and unique emoji using gradients and the mesh tool. These elements must have a complexity and 3d quality. Your emoji should be interesting and exciting when blown up to the size of 18” x 24”. Use docking stations to ensure that this will be done.

Your 5 emoji should include

Two “yellow face”/portrait emoji in the following categories

-You

-Someone you know



Three other emoji created for the following categories

-School

-Art and/or Design

-Favorite thing



Once again... All emoji should be **vector based** images created in Illustrator. You are highly encouraged to create emoji that have NEVER been seen before.

How do you create emoji that show your own style as an artist/designer?

How will you create emoji that no one else can claim them as their own?

*All emoji must be appropriate to display to a large audience.
